PROCEDURAL INFORMATION REGARDING SCHOOL LIFE

Christian Academy in Mozambique uses a “take-home envelope” for school communications. When you receive the envelope with contents, review the contents, respond if appropriate, and sign the envelope in the address box describing the contents. Return the envelope to school the next day with your child. A lost or non-returned envelope will require a new envelope, which will be paid by the family.

Each secondary student enrolled in a math or science course should have and use his or her own scientific calculator. This means that some families will need to purchase additional units so each student has one.

Students are required to wear uniforms as described in the student handbook. Orders can be placed through the school secretary. The goal is to have the best atmosphere possible for learning and instruction. We expect good grooming, modesty, neatness, and cleanliness. The uniforms required for PE are described in the student handbook.

In the middle of each quarter a progress report is completed on each student. This enables the parents to follow the progress of their child and allow for correction to avoid failure. Report cards are issued four (4) times during the year. For secondary students, the semester grades are important and accumulate for graduation and qualification for university entrance.
