## School Supplies

Parents are responsible to provide their children with the following supplies. Please make sure they have enough, especially pencils, paper, erasers, etc., at all times.

### Kindergarten:

### Grades 1-2

## **Towels**

Each student should bring one dark colored hand towel for school use – so towels can be changed several times each week; staff will keep them washed and clean.

## School Dress

Students will wear uniforms which are neatly designed, and of pleasing colors. These are navy blue and white. We believe that uniforms will contribute to school pride and identity, remove class consciousness, save on clothing expenses in the long run, and also contribute to awareness in the community of the school's existence.

*The school uniform rules apply when pupils are in uniform; both at school and in public.*

**Be sure to write the name of student on all uniform components, including shoes**

### ***Boys:***

- Shirt** – Plain white cotton school shirt with collar and buttons, short sleeved, with school emblem attached by sewing on the pocket. It will have a square bottom and worn outside the shorts – not tucked in.
- Shorts** – Navy blue material, with button and fly, no shorter than 9 cm from the knee (measuring from the center of the knee cap), and no longer than the knee cap. Boys uniform will be measured to size, not large enough to fall around hips. Belt loops and black or navy belt must be worn.
- Pair of Pants** – One (1) pair of long pants for winter.
- Shoes** – Black school Toughes or trainers with no colored or white markings; no white soles, gold buckles, etc. No sandals or open shoes allowed.
- Socks** – White ankle sports socks.
- Jacket** – Navy Blue Windbreaker
- Sports** – Blue cotton drawstring or elasticized style shorts, with a white T-shirt.

### ***Girls:***

- Shirt** – Plain white cotton school shirt with collar and buttons, short sleeved, with school emblem attached by sewing on the pocket. It will have a square bottom and is to be worn outside the skirt.
- Skort** – Shorts with skirt-like panel in front. Navy blue material. Plain in front with three buttons and a belt, with elasticized back. The Skort should be no shorter than 9 cm above the knee measured from the center of the knee cap, and no longer than calf length.
- Pair of Pants** – One (1) pair of long pants for winter.
- Shoes** – Black school Toughes or trainers with no colored or white markings; no white color on any part of shoe, i.e., no white soles, no gold buckles, etc. No sandals or open shoes allowed.
- Socks** – White ankle sports socks.
- Jacket** – Navy blue windbreaker
- Sports** – Blue cotton drawstring or elasticized style shorts, with a white T-shirt.

**The school monogram (CAM) is to be on the shirt on the left front pocket.**

Check with the school secretary about having uniforms made and the CAM monogram put on the uniform
